

➔ Post FIER-DOC: start a 3-year Doctoral programme

Option 1 with a French company: the Cifre fellowships programme

A public-private partnership framework, involving:

- a 3-year full time work contract with a French company, minimum gross annual salary of € 23 484;
- a co-supervision by your academic thesis supervisor in your academic laboratory and by your monitor in your company which is strongly involved in the research process.

The candidate gains a valuable experience in both business and public worlds by understanding their different research aims and approaches.

The Cifre fellowships programme is managed by ANRT (Association Nationale de la Recherche et de la Technologie) on the behalf of the French Ministry of Higher Education and Research and eligible for a first doctorat thesis only.



Option 2 with a public research laboratory

A programme in a University, an Engineering Institute and/or a Research Organization (CNRS, INRIA, INRA, CEA, etc.).

There are typically two ways of funding:

- a scholarship from your country of origin or, under conditions, from the French laboratory, called a Doctoral Contract, with a net salary of € 1 400/month;
- a scholarship called "EIFFEL" from the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs. The doctoral programme is a Joint Degree PhD called "CoTutelle" with a thesis co-supervised by two laboratories, one French and one from a foreign country.

In all cases the FIER-DOC can lead to a certificate and 30 ECTS credits.

Training for international governance of research

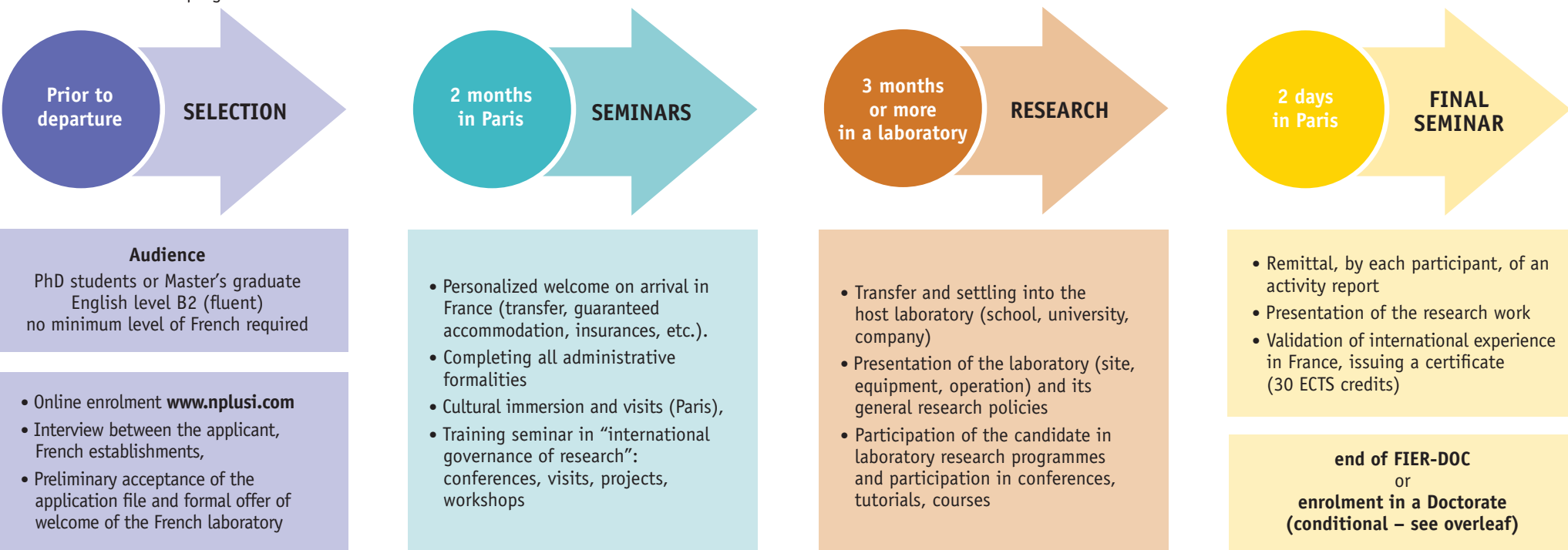
➔ The strong points of FIER-DOC programme

A training, organized by Network "n+i", in governance of research activities

- Personalized welcome on arrival in France, cultural immersion and visits, language discovery, completing all administrative formalities
- Visits to public or private research laboratories, industrial sites
- Training seminar in «governance of international research»: conferences, visits, workshops on themes:
 - Ethics, the researcher's social responsibility
 - Scientific publications (journals, reviews, conferences), where to publish?
 - Industrial and intellectual property, patents
 - Data protection, cyber security, plagiarism research
 - Research funding (public, private), co-research (companies)
 - Communication (media training)
 - Social networks (LinkedIn, etc.)

➔ Objectives

- Enabling candidates to gain «research» experience for 3 months (or more) in their field of skills in France (public or private laboratory)
- Acquiring knowledge required for governance of research projects useful to any future director of research programmes



➔ Costs of FIER-DOC programme

These costs represent academic costs and accompanying services (exclusive of subsistence costs, insurance, visa and plane tickets).

Cost of the 5-month FIER-DOC programme

€ 8 500

Two sessions beginning: 1st February or 1st October

Please notice that all prices are valid for 2017 and are revisable. NB: French laws impose a mean bonus (565/month min.) paid by the laboratory to the person taking part in a research internship.
