The two years programme will start in October 2019.

→ *It aims to provide an understanding of the theory and practice of emergency management in local, national and international contexts (knowledge and skills needed for disaster response in Europe and in the world)*

▶ **Candidates shall be young graduates or those who are studying master program at present, as well as young professionals up to 28 years old.**

▶ **The language of education is 100% English. Optional Intensive French language courses will be offered in order to facilitate integration into day-to-day life in France.**

Candidates applying for the available scholarships should meet the below listed requirements:

- Bachelor or Master degree in:
 - *environmental science*
 - *engineering disciplines (geosciences, informatics, mechanics)*

- *chemistry*
- Others (security, health sciences)
- Good English level (TOEFL or IELTS: Upper Intermediate, B2 minimum).
- Knowledge of French language is welcomed but not mandatory. As a minimum, candidate shall be ready/eager to learn French.

The selection process is as follows:

1. Potential candidate should apply on the following platform : <https://msc.mines-telecom.asia> and upload his/her bachelor diplom , CV, motivation letter as well as language skills certificate by **April 15th 2019**.
2. Preliminary selection will be done based on CV, a language certificate & a motivation letter by IMT Mines Ales
3. ***Final selection by TOTAL*** (based on their own specific criteria, there is no automatic link between academic selection and availability of scholarship
4. Selected candidates will be informed electronically of the selection process results.
